Stratavault Soil Cells & Stormwater System



Stratavault will add life to your urban trees and assure ongoing success for your streetscape projects. Trees in urban areas struggle due to a lack of soil volume for their tree roots. Stratavault soil cells provide structural support to surrounding sidewalks and roads while also creating a void space underneath for soil for the tree's roots to grow. Plus, water can be directed to the underground soil cells where it can be naturally filtered before entering our water systems.

FocalPoint High-Performance Bioretention System



FocalPoint is a modular biofiltration system designed to manage both stormwater quantity and quality. FocalPoint uses physical, chemical and biological means to remove pollutants from stormwater. This system offers efficiency and durability with the use of engineered soils and a highly pervious underdrain system.

The key to FocalPoint's performance is its unique biofiltration media. This mix provides high flow rates and can be modified to target and remove certain pollutants. FocalPoint is a LID system with a much smaller footprint than traditional biofiltration systems.

GEOSYNTHETIC PRICING ANNOUNCEMENT

As many of you know, the pricing for geosynthetic materials is extremely volatile. As a result of reduced traveling in cars and planes across the world in 2020 and still today, petroleum refining production has remained at historical lows. Propylene, a product result of that petroleum refining process, is one of the main building blocks for a wide variety of geosynthetics. Because of this supply shortage and the high demand for geosynthetics, we have seen huge volatility in the pricing of all types of geosynthetics.

We have received significant monthly pricing increase letters from all manufacturers, some even sending more than one increase letter in a month. It has become a challenging time on the supply side to quote projects.

We understand well the construction cycle you participate in. Projects you quote in a “low-bid” environment do not require material procurement for months, and you expect us to hold our pricing. That is always our intention, and our track record reflects this position. However, we are truly in uncharted waters today, and to sustain our business, we must increase our prices as a result of current market conditions.

We are continuing to monitor the situation and do everything we can to limit any unreasonable increases and will also keep you informed if and when this pricing issue will get back under control. We are actively getting information from within our industry and outside to verify any statements made to ensure we are getting our customers the very best pricing possible.

Thank you for your understanding and for your business. As always, if this pricing pressures changes, we will certainly let you know and can share any savings if they become available. 


Here are two examples:



So here it is: ProSpec Salt Barrier recommends spraying their product with a coverage of 150 SqFt per gallon. Pro tip: identify a 10’ x 15’ area of PaveDrain and mark it with lath or sticks before spraying one gallon of ProSpec. Repeat until your entire project is protected.
